The following rules and regulations apply to all vendors:

- Contract deadline is October 25, 2017.
- Reservations will be confirmed **October 27, 2017**.
- First come/first serve on space assignment.
- Mo refunds.
- A fee of **\$30.00** will be charged for any returned checks.
- *This fair is not limited to homemade items. If selling commercial products, must have pre-approval!*
- Most spaces will be 10'x8' on average.
- No displays can go beyond the marked boundaries of the booth; this includes *all* tables and chairs used in the booth.
- All exhibits must allow room to exit.
- Exhibitors must bring extension cords if they have a space with electricity.
- No food items may be offered without permission from Girl Scout Troop 3623.
- Tax matters are the responsibility of the exhibitors. Contact the Washington State Department of Revenue for information and the temporary permits.
- Exhibitors may only have FREE drawings or raffles.
- Volunteers will be available to direct you to the best unloading and parking areas. Please unload as quickly as possible and *move your vehicle immediately* so others may do the same. We must ask that everyone cooperate by not blocking entrances, exits, or roadways.
- All exhibitors must check in for space assignment.
- Exhibitors must have someone attending their exhibit until closing both days.
- Mo animals. {Exception: Service Animals}

Saturday: Doors will be open at 8:00AM for set-up. Vendors must be "show ready" by 9:45AM.
