February 10	Order Taking Begins
February 15	Booth Sale Sign-ups begin
February 25	Pre-Order Taking Ends: Orders due to troops. Distribute goal getter cards so girls can continue taking orders.
February 26	Troop Cookie Orders due in eBudde
February 28	SUCM Order Verification: Check troop pre-orders in eBudde, and SUBMIT final orders.
March 15	Cookie Scholarship deadline for 2012. Applies to girls in the 7th grade or higher.
March 17-22	Delivery: Cookies delivered to warehouses and Service Units. Troops schedule Pick-up with your SU.
March 23	Booth Sales Begin: Troops may reorder through the SUCM. Troops verify reorders placed in eBudde.
April 15	Last Day of Cookie Sale
April 19	Troop Locked Out 11:59 pm: Troops make final deposits, enter incentive order in eBudde and SUBMIT.
April 22	SUCM Lock Out 11:59 pm : SUCM check troop orders, SUBMIT incentives, mail troop deposits and any additional paperwork to the Spokane Council office.
Approximately last week of May	Incentives arrive to the SU. Troops check with the SUCM to schedule pickup and distribute to girls.
June 30	Final troop incentive corrections for this cookie theme year 2012.
