The Girl Scouts Eastern Washington & Northern Idaho ("GSEWNI"), Parent(s) or Guardian(s) and Leader(s) agree to the following terms and conditions. Unless otherwise specifically identified by rank, the *term* Girl Scouts means Brownie, Junior, Cadette, and Senior Girl Scouts or any other Girl served under GSEWNI Council or Girl Scouts of the U.S.A.

The Parent(s)/Guardian(s), Leader(s) and GSEWNI agree that safety is a primary concern and agree to educate each Brownie, Junior, Cadette, and Senior Girl Scout to comply with **all Safety-Wise** standards set forth by Girl Scouts of the USA *not just* those listed here.

- 1) Girl Scouts must wear a Girl Scout pin, uniform component, and/or carry a membership card to identify themselves as Girl Scouts;
- 2) Girl Scouts shall be familiar with the areas/neighborhoods in which they will sell and deliver product;
- 3) Girl Scouts always use the "Buddy System";
- 4) Brownie and Junior Girl Scouts must be closely accompanied by an adult when taking orders, selling or delivering products;
- 5) Cadette/Senior Girl Scouts participating in door-to-door sales activities must be supervised by an adult;
- 6) Girl Scouts shall not enter the home of a stranger;
- 7) Girl Scouts shall be allowed to participate in door-to-door sales or deliver products only during daylight hours, unless closely accompanied by an adult;
- 8) Girl Scouts operating in conjunction for a sales effort or manning a booth in or at a store, mall or other public place must have adults present at all times;
- 9) Girls shall never give out their names, telephone numbers or addresses to customers or anyone asking, but, rather, may only give out the Leaders' names or other designated phone numbers to customers or anyone asking for information, reorders or complaints;
- 10) Girl Scouts may not sell product(s) on the Internet;
- 11) Girl Scouts collect money when the product(s) are delivered unless specifically directed otherwise by GSEWNI or the Troop Product Sales Coordinator/Manager;

Girl Scouts, Leaders, and Girl Scout Parent(s)/Guardian(s) must return all money not later than the due date that is set forth at the time that the product is received by the Girl Scout/Leader/Girl Scout Parent(s)/Guardian(s). If money is due for product, the Girl Scout/Girl Scout Parent/Guardian/Leader hereby knowingly and voluntarily submit to Washington jurisdiction and law. Venue for any proceedings shall be Spokane County, Washington. The prevailing party in any action will be entitled to recover all costs and fees associated with any action that is related to or arises out of this Agreement, including reasonable attorney's fees and costs.

GSEWNI shall replace damaged or broken product, so long as such product is quickly reported or returned to GSEWNI after discovery of the damage. Girl Scouts, Leaders and Parent(s)/Guardian(s) understand that, unless accompanied by a specific written complaint, product ordered will be non-returnable once received.
