Mary Jo Moore RN is the Director of Critical Care and Cardiac Services at Providence Sacred Heart Medical Center. She is responsible for a personnel and supply budget in excess of \$5 million dollars on an annual basis. She has 5 Nurse Managers who report directly to her, and those managers oversee approximately 532 employees. She received her Masters in Organizational Leadership from Gonzaga University in 2007 and has served as Adjunct Faculty for the Nursing Department. She has been appointed to a variety of volunteer positions with the American Association of Critical Care Nurses (AACN), including serving as the Program Chair of the National Teaching Institute in 2012. This is an annual educational conference that draws an attendance of over 7,000 nurses from across the world. In 2013 she was awarded the Circle of Excellence Award from AACN which is only given to 25 nurses annually. That award is given to those nurses who demonstrate excellence in nursing, leadership skills and professionalism. Mary Jo is an avid Gonzaga basketball fan and can be found at every home game. She has passed on her love of nursing to her daughter who currently resides in Seattle and works in the health care field. In a profession that is overwhelmingly female, working with young women as they begin to decide on future goals is something she is very interested in and looks forward to having that opportunity as a member of the board.
