Pinewood Derby Rules and Regulations

Car Dimension Rules

- The overall length of the car shall not exceed 7 inches.
- The overall width of the car shall not exceed 2 ¾ inches.
- The car must have 1 \(^3\)4 clearance between the wheels.
- The car must have 3/8 clearance underneath the body.

Derby Car Weight Rules

- The car shall not exceed 5.0 ounces. All weights must be attached securely to the car.
- The official race scale that is used at the car check-in shall be considered final.

Car Modifications Not Allowed

- The official pinewood block must be used. The block may be shaped in any way that is desired.
- Official wheels must be used. Wheels may not be cut, drilled, beveled, or rounded. But, you may remove the seams and imperfections from the wheels.
- The axels must not be moved or altered. No oil, grease, or wet lubricants allowed. However, they can be polished and lubricated with graphite.

Other Pinewood Derby Race Rules

- Once a car passes inspection and is entered into the race, only race committee members can touch it.
- If the car loses a wheel, or is otherwise damaged, the racer shall have 5 minutes to make repairs.
- Each car must pass inspection by the official inspection committee before it will be allowed to compete.
- The Inspection Committee has the responsibility to disqualify those cars that do not meet these rules.
- Parents should serve mostly as a coach, allowing their child to do as much work on the car as she can physically and safely accomplish. The level of involvement will vary based on age, and physical capabilities.
- Girl Scouts need to race a NEW originally designed car each year. Cars from years past will not be raced. Open class (leaders, parents, siblings friends, etc.) registered cars do not have to be original.
- Cars will not be accepted the day of the race. Cars must be checked in the night before. You do not have to accompany your car for check in.
- This is not a drop off event. Parent or responsible adult must be in attendance.
