## What Girls Need to Participate

- Girls participating in the Fall Sale must be currently registered.
- A signed Parent Permission Form on file with her troop.
- A Fall Product Program packet, which includes a candy/nut order card, money envelope, and a M2 online flyer with information about how to set up an online storefront. For girls who participate online only, a packet is not required.

## Participating Online

Beginning October 1st, girls create an online account in the M2 system.

Within her online account, she creates an avatar with her own virtual likeness, enters e-mail addresses and creates a personal message to send to family and friends. As a way to increase her sales, we also suggest she record her voice for her avatar or upload a personal video explaining what her troop plans to do with the money earned. She then launches her campaign and her personal message is sent with links for her customers to shop for magazines and/or candy/nut items.

Girls should create their online account and send out e-mails early in the program to allow maximum time for their customers to make a purchase.

Payment is collected at the time of order (online via credit card) for all products ordered online (including girl-delivery candy/nut items).

**All orders placed online (including girl-delivery orders) are automatically added to the M2 System so parents need not record/enter any online sales.**

## Timeline

### October 1st

SALE BEGINS! Online & In-Person

### October 1st - 18th

In-person order taking

### October 18th

Family deadline for entering in-person orders into M2OS  
*Online girl-delivered items should not be re-entered*

### October 1st - 22nd

Online girl-delivered order taking

### October 27th

Last day for girls to make reward choices in M2 System

### November 11th - November 16th

Candy/nut items delivered. Check with your troop volunteer for location, date and time to pick up your candy/nut items for girl delivery.

### December 2nd

Money due to troop leader to balance account

### December

Rewards distributed to girls by the troop

## Girl Scout Safety Guidelines

- Always wear a Girl Scout membership pin, uniform sash, vest or other Girl Scout clothing.
- Be familiar with the neighborhoods where they sell.
- Sell door-to-door during daylight hours.
- When selling door-to-door, Girl Scout Juniors and below must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Girl Scout Cadettes and older must be supervised by an adult. Girls must always use the buddy system.
- Never give any customer personal information about herself, including last name, address or phone number.
- Never enter a customer's house
- Have a plan for safeguarding the money collected.
- Check with your troop product sales manager for additional guidelines.

To earn:

- » Create your M2 avatar
- » Send 15+ emails
- » Sell 4+ magazines & 25+ nut/candy items
- » Choose your background & whether your avatar wears her Girl Scout Uniform or Safari outfit!

### Girl Scout Cookie Crossover Patch

To earn:

- » Create your M2 avatar in the fall & send 15+ emails
- » Sell 350+ packages of cookies during the 2021 Girl Scout Cookie Program



Rewards are cumulative. Once the girl's order is placed online by the troop leader, the ordering system will automatically assign the correct rewards to each girl. Rewards will be distributed by the troop leader. Contact that person to find out when and where to pick up the troops items. Girls who are delinquent will not receive their rewards until full amount owed is paid.

## Project Thank You

Project Thank You supports local Armed Forces. Each \$6 donation will provide our military men and women with one can of nuts! There is no better way to say "Thank You" to our local heroes than with a tasty treat.

Girls collect donations and GSEWNI takes care of delivering the product! Each donation is credited to the girl's sales and the Troop receives \$1 in Troop proceeds per donation sold. Girls earn the Care to Share patch by receiving 6 or more donations.
