What Girls Need to Participate

- Girls participating in the Fall Product Program must be currently registered.
- A signed 2024 Parent/Guardian Fall **Permission Form** on file with her troop.
- A Fall Product Program packet, which includes a candy/nut order card, money envelope, and a M2 online flyer with information about how to set up an online storefront. For girls who participate online only, a packet is not required.

Products can not be returned.

Getting Started

Beginning October 4th, Parents/Caregivers will receive an email with a link to access the M2 platform. Girls create an online account in the M2 system to get started:

Within her online account, she creates an avatar with her own virtual likeness, enters e-mail addresses and creates a personal message to send to family and friends. She then launches her campaign and her personal message is sent with links for her customers to shop for magazines/other items and/or candy and nut items online. Girls should create their online account and send out e-mails early in the program to allow maximum time for their customers to make a purchase.

Online Sales

- Customers have a wider selection of shipped products, including tumblers, stationary and Bark Box items.
- Payment is collected at time of order via credit card for all products online (including nuts/chocolate for girldelivery)
- All orders placed online are automatically added to the M2 System so parents need not record/enter any online sales.

Paper Order Card

- Girls take orders for nut/chocolate items using the paper order card. All orders placed in-person are delivered by the girl.
- Payment is collected when products are delivered to the customer. Money is due to the troop on 12/6/24
- All orders placed via the paper order card must be entered into the M2 system.

Safety guidelines

- Always wear a Girl Scout membership pin, uniform sash, vest or other Girl Scout clothing when selling door-to-door
- Be familiar with the neighborhoods where they sell.
- Sell door-to-door during daylight hours.
- When selling door-to-door, Girl Scout Juniors and below must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Girl Scout Cadettes and older must be supervised by an adult. Girls must always use the buddy system.
- Never give any customer personal information about herself, including last name, address or phone number.
- Never enter a customer's house.
- Have a plan for safeguarding the money collected.
- Check with your troop product sales manager for additional guidelines.

Girls who are delinquent will not receive their rewards until full amount owed is paid.
