

Letter from our CEO

I asked you in February to do your best, to be proud of what you do and go for your high goals! <u>And you did it!</u> I now embrace the possibility that you are indeed the best entrepreneurs in the country and I am so proud to know you.

I want to add one more thing that makes so proud to be your CEO. You did the impossible—in a year when the economy was challenged and our customers generally bought fewer boxes, you over performed for our gift of caring program. 41,777 boxes donated to our troops, our first responders and other charitable causes! <u>JUST WOW!</u> That is six percent up from last year. 




Daisy Highlights
