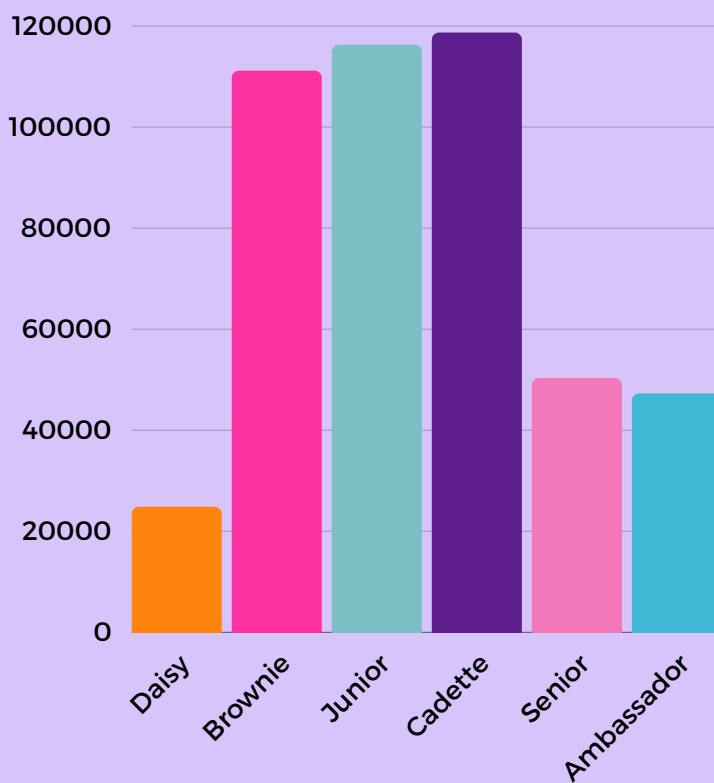
In 2024, **305** Girl Scouts **sold over 1050+ boxes** of cookies selling a combined total of **468,724 boxes!**



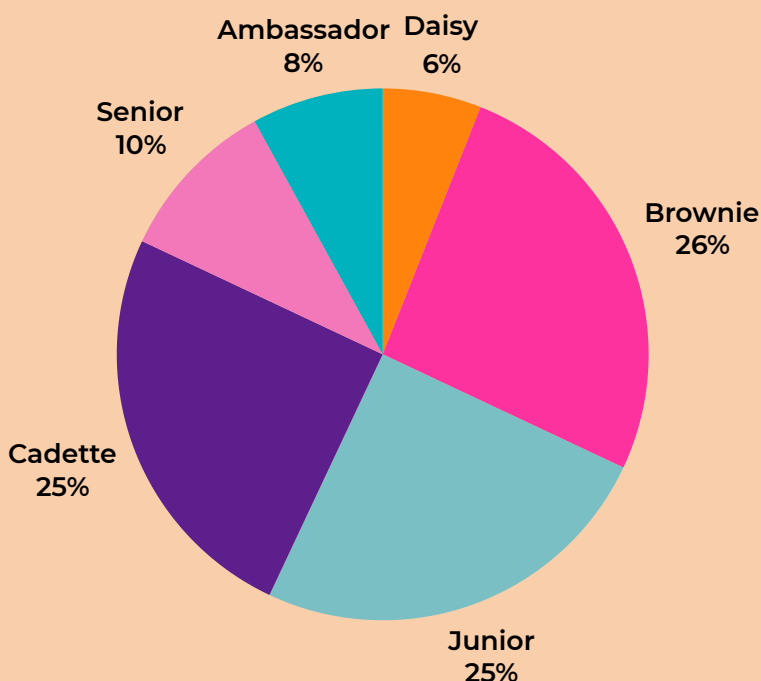
And sold a combined total of **18,509 boxes** For **Troop-to-Troop** donations!

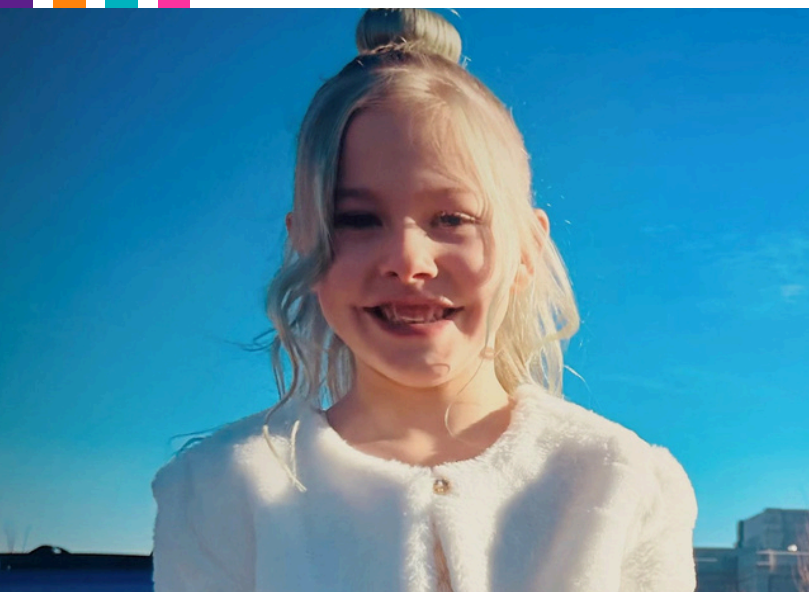

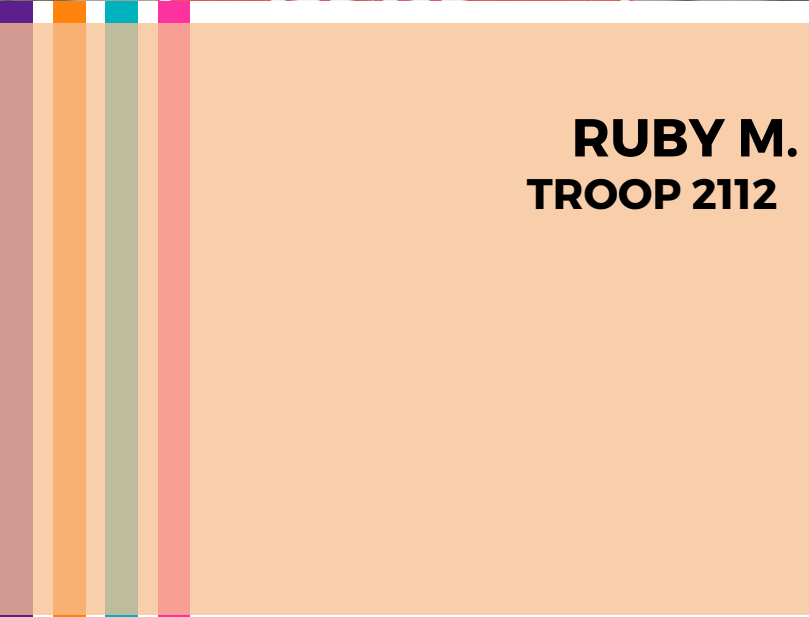

These 79 exceptional sellers make up **9.4%** of all Brownie Girl Scouts who sold cookies in 2024!

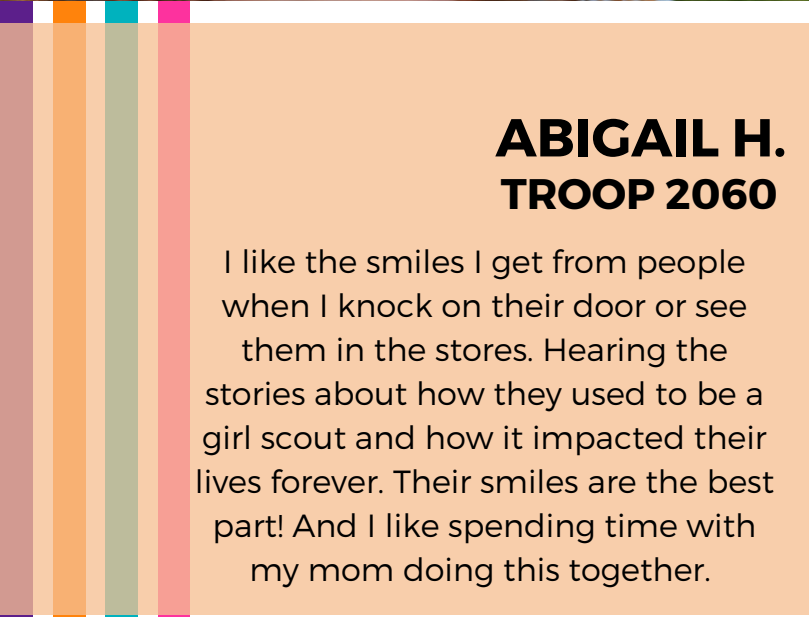
