

Popsicle Stick Girl Scout Cookie Booth Craft

Whether you are a troop leader yourself or you love the Girl Scouts, this wood cookie booth craft is a must do!

Here's your checklist of supplies to bring this craft to life:

- 6 Jumbo Popsicle Sticks
- Craft Paint
- Cardstock Paper
- School Glue
- Scissors
- Washable Markers

Instructions

1. First assemble the base of your cookie stand. You will need SIX jumbo popsicle sticks per craft. The best way I explain this step, is to make a fence but with a large gap in between. Please use my picture for an example.
2. Once you have your popsicle stick shape piece assembled, set aside to let it dry completely.
3. While it's drying, go ahead and cut out embellishments from your cardstock to give your piece that one-of-a-kind look. I did small cookie boxes, cookie shapes, a wood sign and pendant banner.
4. The next step is completely optional - squirt some paint on a paper plate. Have children paint their popsicle stick shape however they like {I did one in green for mine.}
5. To finish off the Popsicle Stick Cookie Booth Stand - have children add their cardstock pieces and Girl Scout touches to the front of their shape.
6. Then set aside to let it dry completely before displaying proudly!
