

What do Girl Scouts do?

At Girl Scouts, your girl will prepare for a lifetime of leadership, success, and adventure in a safe, no-limits place designed by girls, for girls.

How?

Through engaging, challenging, and fun activities like earning badges, going on trips, selling cookies, exploring science, getting outdoors, and doing community service projects.

At Girl Scouts, she'll lead her own adventure and team up with other girls to choose the hands-on activities that interest her most. Along the way, your girl will gain important skills in four areas that form the foundation of Girl Scouts:

STEM, Outdoors, Life Skills, and Entrepreneurship

Ways to Participate

Girl Scouts by Age Levels

Girls in grades K-12 can join the fun at Girls Scouts. To ensure the best experience, our programming is categorized by grade level. Some troops may be multi-level, with girls in more than one program level making a troop. Volunteers and staff are attentive to promoting activities that are appropriate.

What do I Need to Know?

What is the cost?

The yearly Girl Scout membership fee is \$30 for girls, \$25 for adults.

Is a uniform required?

No, however, the Girl Scout uniform is an official vest, sash, or tunic worn with a white blouse and khaki bottoms, along with the insignia and Girl Scout pins. Though they are not required, we recommend that each girl have a vest, sash, or tunic to display their earned rewards, badges, and patches.

Is financial assistance available?

Yes! Assistance is available for girls and adults who need financial help in order to participate in the Girl Scout program. Assistance is available for membership registration, uniform components, a journey book, and camp.

How do troops sustain themselves?

Girl Scout troops are funded by a share of money earned through council-sponsored product sale activities (such as Girls Scout Cookie sales) and troop money earning activities upon approval (i.e. car washes, craft sales, etc.). Some troops may require minimal troop dues for snacks and patches/badges.

¿Hay asistencia financiera disponible?

¡Sí! Hay asistencia para niñas y adultos que necesitan ayuda financiera para participar en el programa de Girl Scouts. La asistencia está disponible para el registro de ser miembro, componentes del uniforme, libros de viaje y campamento.

¿Cómo se sostienen las tropas?

Las tropas de Girl Scouts son financiados por dinero ganado a través de consejo patrocinado actividades de venta del producto (como ventas de las galletas de Girl Scouts) y actividades para que la tropa pueda ganar dinero (lavar carros, venta de artesanía). Es posible que unas tropas requieran cuotas mínimas por refrescos e insignias/parches.
